High School Varsity Letter Criteria 2024

We will try to work with your school, if not part of HVS, to get you a varsity letter. If we can't get you a varsity letter from your home school, we can get you a Milford varsity letter.

Athletes wishing to apply for the "Alternate Path" for a varsity letter must be active in an additional cycling team and apply to the head coach by August 1.

However, in general riders will be expected to attend at least 1-2 HVUR rides a week and will have to be active in another cycling team. If you would like to apply for this path please document your ride plans for the August 1st thru the end of the MiSCA season. Include rides with your other cycling team, HVUR rides that you plan to attend, and any solo training days. Also, please list all of the races that you have scheduled for the 2023 season including races outside the August through mid October timeframe. Have this document signed by your other team's head coach and submit it to hvunitedracing@gmail.com . The team's head coaches will collectively make a decision and let the rider know within two weeks of submission
